Curricular Changes

Please continue reporting on the long-term effect of state-mandated changes in undergraduate education and corresponding changes to the NAAB-accredited program. The program's overall strategy should be included in the next *Architecture Program Report*.

Finances

The program is advised to include this review of the issues facing state institutions in Louisiana as well as recent developments in this area in its *Special Focused Evaluation Program Report* due in June. The program is also encouraged to share the results of the state Board of Regents review with the NAAB as soon as they are available.

Faculty

The program is also advised to begin reviewing *The NAAB 2009 Conditions for Accreditation* in order to ensure that developments and changes made in response to the 2009 VTR will also be responsive to the *Conditions* that will be in effect at the time of the 2015 visit.
